Dr. Katherine Voyles serves as the Program Director for the School for Academic Degrees at the Graduate School for Army Chaplain Corps Professional Development in the U.S. Army Institute for Religious Leadership. She was previously hired as the Editor of the *U.S. Army Chaplain Corps Journal*.

From 2010-2020 Dr. Voyles taught in civilian academia. From 2010-2020 she taught interdisciplinary courses on writing, research writing, and literature at the University of Washington, Bothell. From 2009-2015 she taught courses on the humanities, literature, and writing at Seattle Pacific University.

Dr. Voyles continues to publish widely in her academic field. Her articles and reviews have appeared in peer-reviewed venues since 2008. She also writes and edits for public audiences. Since 2016 her work has appeared in fora including *Foreign Policy*, *Task & Purpose*, *Small Wars Journal*, *War on the Rocks*, *Public Books*, and the *Los Angeles Review of Books*. She is co-managing editor of *The Strategy Bridge*.

Dr. Voyles holds a Ph.D. in English from the University of California, Irvine, and Master of Arts degree from the University of California, San Diego. She earned her B.A. from the University of Washington.
