

CH(CPT) Juman Kim, D.Min ECPE Director, School for Spiritual Care – Army CPE

CH (CPT) Juman Kim was born on April 22, 1987, in Chuncheon, South Korea. He also lived in Vietnam and Cambodia before moving to the United States. He is a graduate of Washington State University, Spokane, Washington (B.A., 2010), Faith Evangelical College & Seminary (M.Div., 2013), and Wesley Theological Seminary (D.Min., 2024). He completed five units of Clinical Pastoral Education. Before joining the chaplaincy, he pastored churches in Washington State for over five years.

CH (CPT) Kim was commissioned as a Chaplain in the United States Army and entered active duty on January 10, 2017. His first assignment was at Fort Bragg, NC, serving with the 307th BSB, 1 BCT, 82nd Airborne Division. He then served as a resident CPE chaplain at Madigan Army Medical Center at JBLM, WA. To utilize his 7R skill, he was assigned to the 254th Combat and Operational Stress Control unit at Baumholder, Germany. CH Kim currently serves as the ECPE Director for the School for Spiritual Care - Army CPE at the Institute for Religious Leadership at Fort Jackson, SC.
